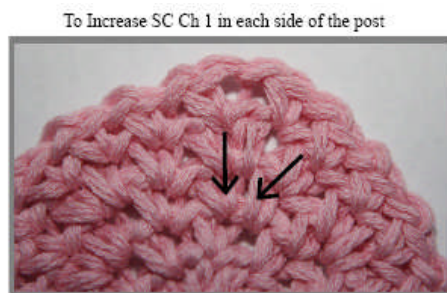
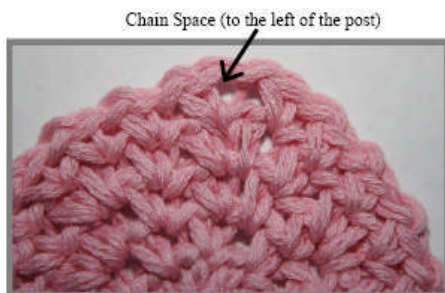

CHRIS'S CHEMO CAP



Materials:

1 Skein Caron Simply Soft Yarn - (optional – shown a small amount of yarn for an optional contrasting color)
Hook Size: L (8 mm) and M (9 mm)

HELPFUL HINTS:

Every other row is an increase row after round 4. The increase rows are all the same.

This is a very forgiving pattern.

If you skip a chain don't worry about it.

If your stitch count does not come out exactly don't worry about that either. Just continue on as if it did.

When you begin the cap if your round is wavy it means you have too many stitches.

Cap is made in a spiral. Stitch used throughout: Single Crochet (SC), Chain One (Ch1)

With smaller hook, Ch 3, join with slip stitch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: (*SC, Ch1) 9 times. (9sc, 9ch spaces) *Mark the beginning of each round.*

Rnd 2: SC Ch 1 into first SC, skip next Ch, SC, Ch1 into next 8 Ch Spaces from previous round. (9sc, 9ch spaces)

Rnd 3: *(SC, Ch1 into next Ch Space: SC, Ch1 into next SC, SC Ch 1 into next Ch Space) Repeat from * around to last Ch, SC, Ch1 into last Ch space. (13sc, 13ch spaces)

Rnd 4: Repeat Round 3. (19sc, 19ch spaces)

Rnd 5: (*SC, Ch1 into each Ch Space) from previous round. (19sc, 19ch spaces)

Rnd 6: (*SC, Ch1 into next 2 Ch Spaces, SC Ch1 into next SC: SC, Ch1 into next Ch Space*) repeat from * around. SC, Ch1 into last Ch space. (25sc, 25ch spaces)

For an average size woman's head: Continue repeating Rounds 5 and 6 until diameter of your round reaches 5.5 inches.

For an average size man's head: Continue until the diameter reaches 6 inches.

When desired size of your diameter is reached, Change to Larger Hook and (*SC, Ch1 into each Ch Space) from previous round. Repeat form * around.

Continue (*SC, Ch1 in each Ch Space) until desired length of cap is obtained.

7 inches for an average woman and 7-8 inches for an average man.

To change colors: Pull new color thru loop of your last SC. Ch1 with the new color and continue your (*SC, Ch1 in each Ch Space) around.

Weave in ends.
