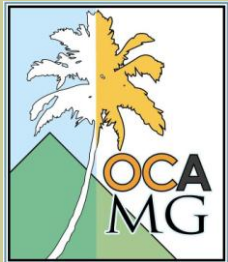

- ❖ If you have both Medicare and full Medicaid coverage, you should have the following benefits
 - 1 **EXTENSIVE DRUG COVERAGE:**
 - Extensive drug coverage, including generics and brand names.
 - No co-pay for generic drug.
 - No monthly premium for Medicare Part D.
 - 2 **FREE TRANSPORTATION FROM YOUR HOME TO DOCTOR'S OFFICE:**
 - Absolutely free and unlimited transportation from your residence to your family physician's office or to medical specialist's office.
 - 3 **YOU ARE FREE TO SEE ANY MEDICAL SPECIALIST AT YOUR CHOICE:**
 - As with regular Medicare, you can see any specialist who accepts Medicare, either by self refer or by Direct Referral system. No need for authorization for office consult, once per month to any medical specialist. If you need other services, such as surgery, admission, and other, please consult your Primary Care Physician or OCAMG.
 - 4 **MEDICAL EXPENSES WHEN YOU TRAVEL :**
 - You will have up to \$25,000 emergency international coverage while you travel outside USA

5 DENTAL CARE, OPTOMETRY, PODIATRY:

Starting July 2009, Medi-Cal has eliminated the following benefits: dental care, optometry, podiatry, and others. However, members of OCAMG will continue to have dental care, optometry, podiatry free of charge.

6 EMERGENCY CARE:

- In case of emergency, you are free go to any Emergency Room, any hospital in any city, any state, 24 hours per day.

7 MANY OTHER BENEFITS:

- Free membership at 24 Hours Fitness Center, Bally Fitness, YMCA, or the Curves.
- Viagra, Cialis or Levitra each month if you have prescription
- You may select one of these two extra benefits.

INFORMATION FOR MEDICARE ONLY BENEFICIARIES:

- \$0 premiums for Medical, Part D and Dental, Vision care.
- \$0 copay for doctor office visit and inpatient hospital care.
- You don't have to pay for Medicare Supplement Insurance (Save \$150-\$250 per month)
- You don't have to pay a monthly premium for Part D (Save \$25-50 per month)
- You have all of the above benefits with certain copays.

You are limited to making changes in your Medicare Advantage plan and Part D prescription drug plan options only between **November 15 - December 31** each year except as follows:

If you are eligible to join or are already a member of a Medicare Advantage plan, you may be able to make one change to your coverage by not later than **March 31**. You could join or switch Medicare Advantage plans, or leave your plan and get Original Medicare as long as you do not add or drop drug coverage.

If you are new to Medicare (65th birthday or disabled), you can join a Medicare Advantage plan (HMO, PPO, PFFS) or a stand-alone Part D prescription drug plan during the period that starts three months before the month you get Medicare, and ends three months after you get Medicare.

If you have both Medicare and full Medicaid coverage, you can join a Medicare Advantage plan (HMO, PPO, and PFFS) or a stand-alone Part D prescription drug plan at any time.
